

**Materials:**

Suggested Yarn: Lily Sugar'n Cream Solids
 Yarn Weight: Worsted Cotton / 10 ply (9 wpi)
 Hook: US F

Memo:

Too small? Add a row, or substitute hdc for sc in round 5.

Directions:

With MC make a magic loop: ch 1, 6 sc in loop. Pull tail and close loop. (6 sections)

Round 1: 2 sc in each sc (12sc) (2 sc in each section)

Round 2: (2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next sc) repeat to end. (18 sc) (3 sc in each section)

Round 3: (2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 2 sc) repeat to end. (24 sc) (4 sc in each section)

Round 4: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, repeat to end. (30 sc) (5 sc in each section)

Round 5: (2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 4 sc) repeat to end. (36 sc) (6 sc in each section)

Round 6: (2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 5 sc) repeat to end. (42 sc) (7 sc in each section)

Sl st last chain into first sc of the round. Ch 1.

Round 7: 1 sc in each sc, FLO. (42 sc). Bind off. Weave in ends.

Place a piece of yarn, or stitch marker) every 7th stitch, starting with the 1st stitch (1, 8, etc) for doing the crossing chains next.

Add in crossing chains.

You will be skipping around the edge of the coaster, in the direction that you crochet.
 Right or Left depending on your handedness.

Sl st into the 2nd stitch of the last round. Sc in the next 12 sts (st#14), Ch 14.

Count over 21 sts. Or, go to the third marker (f) over.

Sc into st#36 (marker f).

Sc into next 6 sts (you are at st#42).

Ch 14, and sc into st#22 (marker d). Sc into next 13 sts (you are at st#35).

Ch 14, and sc back at st#15 (marker c). Sc into last 6 sts.

Ch 14, and sc into st#1 (Start). (Consider weaving over/under here)

You should be back at the start.

Next, sc into each of the 42 st of the crossing chain row. Slst into 1st st.

Bind off, weave in ends.

Variations: Slst instead of sc for last round of crossing chain. So you can use BLO or FLO.
